

Dogs at River Ridge Trails Policy

Dogs are welcome on all trails at River Ridge Trails. Dog owners are responsible for their dog's behaviour at all times. The owner of a dog is responsible for maintaining control over their pet and to be in abidance of any bylaws etc. that govern having a pet in public. If another trail user interfered with by a dog and suffers bodily injury, the owner of the dog will be personally responsible for any damages incurred.

Dogs are not allowed to be "running at large" at any time in River Ridge Trails. As per the bylaws of the Town of Langham (2008-12) and the RM of Corman Park (32/20), running at large is defined as:

when it is not under control by being:

- i. in direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or
- ii. securely confined within an enclosure; or
- iii. securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.

Any dogs and owners found to be in violation of the applicable bylaws of the Town of Langham or the RM of Corman Park will be subject to any and all enforcement measures applicable under the bylaws.

Additionally, in consideration of other trail users, please respect the following:

- Keep your dogs under control at all times either by reliable recall or leash.
- Please keep your dog leashed at all times in the parking lot.
- Clean up after your dog and please any waste in the trash cans near the parking lot

During specific sporting events, dogs may be prohibited from accessing the property, or additional restraining requirements may be put in place as deemed necessary by the trail's governance board and/or the event host. Any suspension of all or part of this policy for events will be communicated and signed appropriately.
